New artwork for the Park



As widely publicised in local and national media, following public consultation the steering group set up to assist Southwark in commissioning a new artwork for the park selected Conrad Shawcross' *Three Perpetual Chords*. Inspired by the mathematical patterns found in music, Conrad describes the work – which will be in three separate cast-iron forms of increasing complexity – as visual descriptions of musical chords.

The precise location of the pieces has yet to be confirmed. Installation is expected around September 2014.
